Main Screen

◆ **Main Screen:** can be used for accessing the different desktops, taking a screen image with the snapshot tool and access the settings dialog.

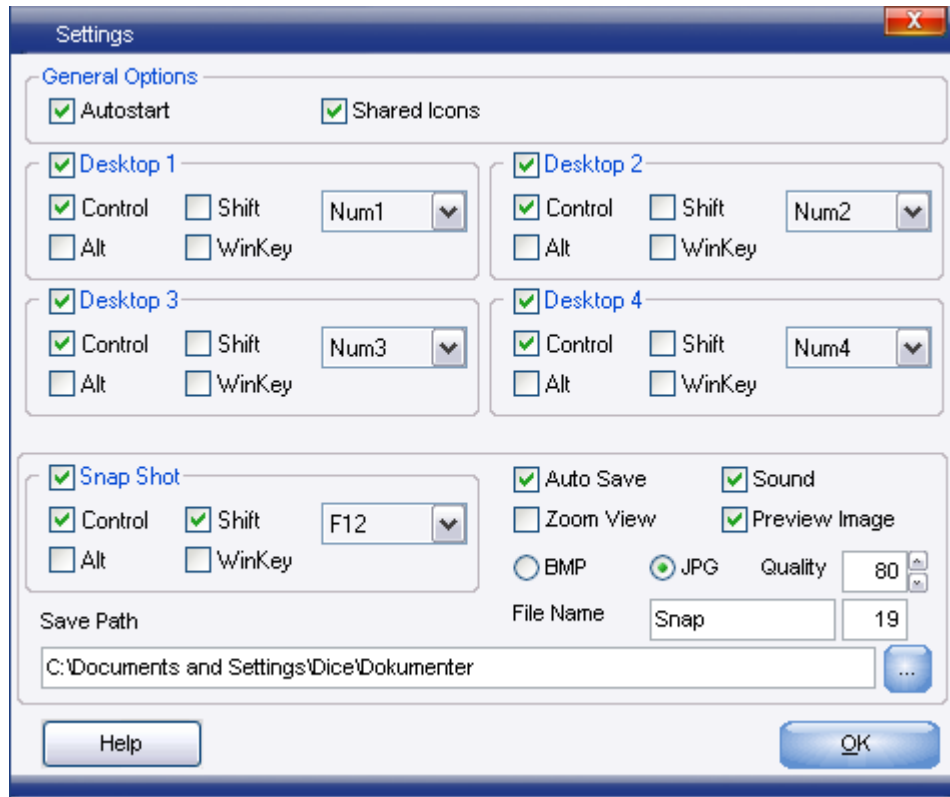


- **Button 1, 2, 3, 4:** Switch between the four desktops
- **Camera:** Snapshot tool activates the image capture feature.
- **Gear wheel:** Opens the settings dialog.
- **Minimize (blue bar):** Minimizes the Main Screen to the systray in the lower right corner of the windows bar.




- **Close (red X):** Exits Multi Desktop application and restore all open programs on other desktops to the normal desktop (number 1).

Settings Dialog



- ◆ **Desktop Hot Keys:** Configure the desktop hotkeys individually for each desktop.
- ◆ **Snap Shot:** Configure hotkey that will activate the snap shot tool. You can also specify other snap shot features

File Name: File name and number for automatic saving the screen capture image if **Auto Save** is checked.

Save Path: is the folder where the images taken will be saved. Browse for save path using the button 

Sound: Plays a camera sound when the screen capture / snap shot is taken.

Preview: Opens your normal image view associated with either BMP or JPG

Zoom View: Opens the Magnify / Zoom window when snap shot tool is active.

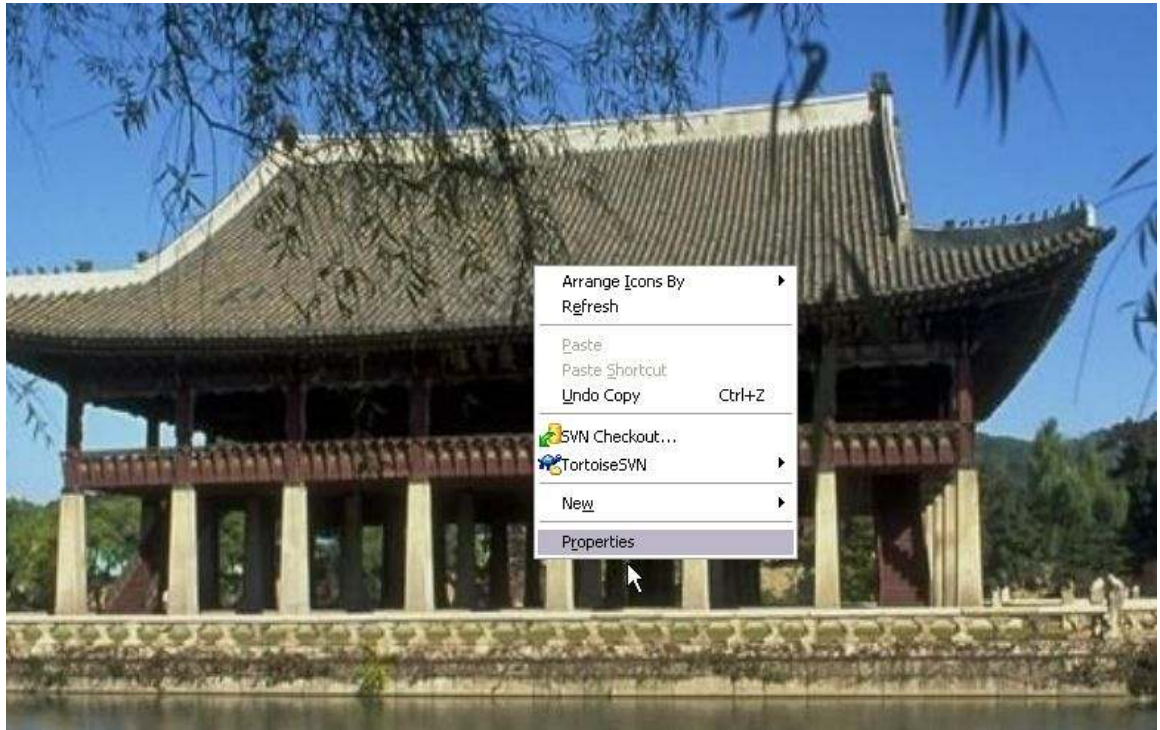
BMP or JPG: The snap shot image can be saved in either Bitmap format (BMP). BMP is a loss less image format and is pixel perfect, but also saves large files. JPG is a compressed image format designed for natural and screen pictures and is much smaller in file size. You can set the quality of the JPG in the box to the right. 70-75 is normal for JPG, but we feel that 80 gives better.

Selecting a Desktop Image

◆ **Desktop Image:** Most people like to have different images on the desktop either beautiful sceneries, flowers, animals, family, art or design.

With Multi Desktop you simply use the standard windows configuration like you would do for the normal desktop and you can do that for all the desktop there are.

◆ **Step 1:** Right Click on the desktop (windows background) and select Properties



◆ **Step 2:** Select the tab “Desktop”. Now pick or browse for the Background Image and select the color and Position you like.



◆ **Step 3:** Click OK and see the new desktop image.



◆ **Step 4:** Switch to the next desktop using MultiDesktop Main Screen or hotkey and repeat step 1, 2 and 3.
